A DAILY SERUM WITH A CLEAR PURPOSE

Cryo-Peptide Concentrate is designed as a lightweight serum for morning and evening use. Its peptide system is paired with multi-level hydration and a controlled cooling sensation. Airless packaging supports precise dosing while helping to protect an advanced formula.

01 Complementary peptides

Four distinct peptide roles create a more complete product story than a single hero ingredient.

02 Hydration and comfort

Humectants and sensorial ingredients balance performance with everyday usability.



FOUR PEPTIDE ROLES. ONE SYSTEM.

The peptides were selected for distinct, complementary roles. Together, they create a balanced story around smoother, firmer and well-conditioned skin, without asking one ingredient to carry the entire narrative.

SIGNAL PEPTIDE PAIR

Palmitoyl Tripeptide-1 + Palmitoyl Tetrapeptide-7

A complementary peptide pair chosen as the backbone of the smoother, firmer-looking skin story. Specific claims require testing of the finished product.

FIRMNESS SUPPORT

Palmitoyl Tripeptide-5

Adds a distinct firmness-focused role and broadens the system beyond a single peptide complex.

SMOOTHING PEPTIDE

Acetyl Hexapeptide-8

Selected for cosmetic positioning around expression lines and a smoother-looking skin surface.

COPPER PEPTIDE

Copper Tripeptide-1

Gives the system a distinctive copper-peptide signature and supports positioning around resilient, vital and well-conditioned skin.

WHAT THE RIGHT PARTNER CAN UNLOCK

Arctic Skin has a clear product and brand framework. The next phase needs experienced operators who can turn the concept into a substantiated, scalable and market-ready reality.



SHARED OBJECTIVE Protect the Nordic identity while making product, claims, packaging and unit economics robust enough for market.

MANUFACTURING

OEM and formula review

Confirm raw material choices, feasibility, cost direction and the route to a pilot batch.

EVIDENCE

Safety and claims

Build a realistic substantiation path for cosmetic claims in the selected target markets.

PACKAGING

Compatibility and scale

Validate the airless format, materials, filling process and stability before production.

MARKET

Distribution and fulfilment

Define a focused launch channel with inventory, logistics and cross-border readiness.

A DISCIPLINED PATH TO MARKET.

The concept is ready to enter qualification, but no efficacy claim or production decision is treated as final until it has been tested and documented.

01

QUALIFY

Review formula goals, raw material access, target markets and the expected cost frame.

02

PROTOTYPE

Develop or adapt lab samples with the intended texture, cooling profile and skin feel.

03

VALIDATE

Complete safety, stability, packaging compatibility and appropriate efficacy assessment.

04

PREPARE

Lock packaging, documentation, pilot batch, fulfilment and a focused route to market.

DECISION GATE

Each stage should create a clear basis to proceed, adjust or stop before the next cost level is triggered.

A FOCUSED STARTING POINT

The first partner discussion should establish practical capability and mutual relevance without requiring disclosure of the protected formula core.

1

Review

Assess the product direction, market and intended partner role.

2

Align

Map capability, timing, minimum volumes and commercial parameters.

3

Scope

Define responsibilities, deliverables and which information requires an NDA.

4

Decide

Agree the next validation gate and a clear owner for it.
